RESPONDENT.)	DISMISSAL

The above-captioned matter came before the Montana Human Rights Commission (Commission) on January 16, 2001. The matter was before the Commission for consideration of the charging party's objection to the dismissal of the complaint. Oral argument was not timely requested and the matter was considered on the record.

After reviewing the record, the Commission finds that the Human Rights Bureau properly dismissed the matter. The record shows that although charging party alleged that respondent was a sponsor of the American Legion Montana Boys State, she provided no evidence to support her allegation. Respondent produced its handbook of sanctioned and/or sponsored activities which did not list or include Boys State as an activity. The Commission found that the investigator properly found that charging party failed to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that respondent had control over or a connection to Boys State sufficient to conclude that the Montana High School Assoc. was a properly named respondent. Accordingly, the matter was properly dismissed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the Human Rights Bureau's order dismissing the complaint is affirmed and the charging party's objection is overruled.
