

The parties have settled this matter, and Human Rights has approved the settlement. The Hearings Bureau contested case file remained open, at the request of Carpozi's counsel, until the last payment pursuant to the settlement agreement, which was to be made by February 28, 2009. On November 10, 2008, the Hearing Officer gave notice of his intent to dismiss this complaint thereafter, unless by close of business on March 13, 2009, a motion that the case remain open because of nonpayment of settlement was filed with the Hearings Bureau. No such motion was filed. The charging party's complaint against Montana Harvest is dismissed as fully settled on the merits. Any settlement provisions regarding affirmative relief remain fully effective according to their terms. Any protective orders or sealing orders issued herein remain in full force and effect according to their terms unless and until modified by a tribunal exercising jurisdiction over the order or orders.
